**Notice of refusal of your application for a variation to your environmental permit**

From 12:00 on Friday 20th December the discharge from Maenan Abbey Caravan park, into the ditch in the field next to the caravan park (grid ref SH 78809 65600) must be stopped.

Any discharge from the caravan park to this location after this time will be classed as a breach of the Environmental Permitting Regulations.

This is because we are refusing the permit, as we have assessed that this discharge is harmful to the environment.

**Rights of appeal**

If you're not happy with our decision to refuse the application you may appeal to the Welsh Ministers. You must make your appeal by 18/06/2020.
