We believe that you have committed the following offence(s):

Offence: Regulation 38(2) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. By failing to comply with or contravene an environmental permit condition, as recorded in CAR_NRW0036058.

We have issued this **warning letter** as a response to the above offence(s) on this occasion. However, our decision could change if any further relevant information comes to light, including, but not restricted to, information that:

- the environmental impacts of this offence is greater than we presently understand them;
- the offences are continuing or have been repeated;
- You have committed other offences of which we are presently unaware.

We will take this offence into account if we consider that you are involved in any future offending.

- prevent any other prosecuting authority taking action against you/the Company; or
- affect our right to issue enforcement, clear-up or remediation notices, or seek recovery of costs or damages according to law.
