
Abstraction Licence 22/61/2/0074 – Succession to Abstraction Licence

It has come to our attention that your husband passed away sometime ago, we would like to offer our condolences and as a matter of courtesy would like to inform you of the requirements for succession of the abstraction licence. A copy of the original licence is enclosed along with form WRF and guidance notes.

It is a requirement under Condition 49 of the Water Resources Act 1991 that any application for succession to the abstraction licence is submitted to Natural Resources Wales within 15 months of the date when Mr Farmer passed away. After this date a new licence application will be necessary for anyone wishing to take the licence on.
