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Part Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of part of the permit for Electrical Carbon, Swansea operated by Morganite Electrical Carbon Limited.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Purpose of this document

Receipt of application

Confidential information

No claim for commercial or industrial confidentiality has been made.

The facility

Control of the facility

We are satisfied that the applicant (now the operator) is the person who will have control over the operation of part of the facility after the grant of the permit. The decision was taken in accordance with EPR RGN 1 Understanding the meaning of operator.

The regulated facility

The permitted regulated facilities have changed as a result of the partial surrender.

This permit applies to only one part of the installation. The names and permit numbers of the operators of other parts of the installation are detailed in the permit's introductory note.

Permit Conditions

Changes to permit conditions

No permit conditions have changed as a result of the partial surrender.

The site

Extent of the surrender application

The extent of the facility has changed as a result of the partial surrender.

The operator has provided an updated site boundary showing the extent of the facility. The sites activities had been moved as part of the variation EPR/VP3339PD/V010, as a result, there will be no change to any of the emission points from the site.

We consider this plan to be satisfactory.

Pollution risk

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility. The Operator has completed several borehole, groundwater and soil reports which were submitted to NRW as part of this surrender. There is no risk to controlled waters or land from the site as a result of the surrender.

Satisfactory state

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to return the site of the regulated facility to a satisfactory state.

In coming to this decision we have had regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation.

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
