

Thank you very much for your email requesting further information in relation to my application for a permit to install a mini treatment plant at my home. I hope that the following information is acceptable.

Having spoken to Mr Mike Jones, the builder who has already been issued with a permit from NRW to discharge the cleansed water into the same place as my request, he informs me that the National Grid Reference for the discharge point is **SN4758320136**.

The Grid Reference for the sampling point is **SN4772020181**.

I also enclose a map indicating the facility site, the outlet pipe and the discharge point. I trust that this map is adequate as I am having difficulty in finding anything more suitable. Mr Jones informed me that NRW supplied him with a map onto which he provided the necessary details.

Also, having spoken to Mr Jones, I note that the discharge point is from a large pipe from where the cleansed water enters a ditch. I am not sure whether this constitutes surface water or ground water.

I trust that this further information will enable you to continue to evaluate my application.
