**Enovert South Limited Tir John
Landfill Gas Utilisation Plant
Compound Decision Document**

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Full Transfer

We have decided to grant the transfer for Tir John Landfill Gas Utilisation Plant Compound from Infinis (Re-Gen) Limited to Enovert South Limited. A minor administrative variation was also completed to change the site address postcode from SA7 9XT to SA1 8LN.

The permit number is EPR/BP3738LS.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

Control of the facility

We are satisfied that the applicant (now the operator) is the person who will have control over the operation of part of the facility after the grant of the permit. The decision was taken in accordance with EPR RGN 1 Understanding the meaning of operator.

Environment Management System

There is no known reason to consider that the operator will not have the management systems to enable it to comply with the permit conditions. The decision was taken in accordance with RGN 5 on Operator Competence. The Environment Management System in place is accredited to ISO14001.

Technical competence

Technical competency is required based on the regulated facility types in the permit. The operator is a member of an agreed scheme, WAMITAB. The operator satisfies the criteria in RGN 5 on Operator Competence.

Relevant convictions

The National Enforcement Database (COLINS) has been checked to ensure that all relevant convictions have been declared. No relevant convictions were found. The operator satisfies the criteria in RGN 5 on Operator Competence.
