**Tradebe Healthcare National
Limited – Wrexham Clinical
Waste Treatment Facility (HDU
& TS)**

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NRW initiated variation

The application number/the permit/variation number is: PAN-009753

The applicant /operator is: Tradebe Healthcare National Limited

The Installation is located at: Wrexham Clinical Waste Treatment Facility (HDU & TS), Marlborough Road, Wrexham Industrial Estate, Wrexham, LL13 9RJ

We have decided to issue an Natural Resources Wales initiated variation for Wrexham Clinical Waste Treatment Facility (HDU & TS) operated by Tradebe Healthcare National Limited.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

This variation adds a new waste code (15 02 02*) to the permit. This will enable the site to store and treat wastes under European Waste Code 15 02 02*. This variation is required to complement the contingency work Public Health Wales are undertaking in relation to waste produced during the deep cleansing of people and properties in a non-healthcare setting where possible cases of COVID 19 have been present. Wastes from the deep cleansing of people and properties in a non-healthcare setting contaminated or potentially contaminated with COVID 19 that has not been stored for at least 72 hours, will be categorised under the European Waste Catalogue as 15 02 02* (absorbents, filter materials (including oil filters not otherwise specified), wiping cloths, protective clothing contaminated by hazardous substances).

Purpose of this document

Receipt of application

Confidential information

No claim for commercial or industrial confidentiality has been made.

We have not identified information provided as part of the application that we consider to be confidential. The decision was taken in accordance with our guidance on commercial confidentiality.

Waste types

We have specified the permitted waste types, descriptions and quantities, which can be accepted at the regulated facility. As part of this variation the following European Waste Code (EWC) has been added into the appropriate table(s):

15 02 02* - absorbents, filter materials (including oil filters not otherwise specified), wiping cloths, protective clothing contaminated by hazardous substances (infectious only)

This EWC will be managed the same as 18 01 03* which is already present within the permit.
