DISCHARGE CONSENTS - NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE TO DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES ANNEX

According to our records, you have a Consent to discharge trade or sewage effluent. The Discharge Consent contains the following condition or one that is similar: -

"The discharger shall notify the Agency in writing if any known introduction or material change in respect of discharges from trade premises...occurs that may increase or introduce into the effluent any "dangerous substance" included on List I, List II, or Red List (set out in Annex ...to this notice as updated from time to time and notified to the discharger in writing)..."

Owing to Regulations issued by DETR, the Environment Agency has reviewed the listing of substances in the Annex to this condition.

The Surface Waters (Dangerous Substances) (Classification) Regulations (SI No 2560 (1997) and SI No 389 (1998)) have made some substances, which had previously been identified in Government circular 7/89, statutory and have added 20 new substances to this list. The Annex listing has also been revised to reflect the additional substances in the Regulations and to include other substances that have become a cause for concern since 1989 when the listing was first issued.

This letter and the attached revised listing serves as the required Notification, referred to in the Consent condition. The change takes immediate effect. Please replace the old list with the new one. Please contact your local Environment Agency office and write or speak to Richard Bysouth if you have any queries about this letter.

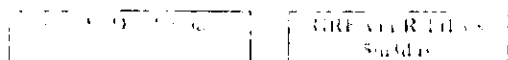

Records held on WIMS show ANGLESEY SEA ZOO BRYNSIENCYN ANGL (CG0145401) to be extant under version 2 issued 07/08/1992 with numeric consent conditions, effective 07/11/1992. The works is currently consented to discharge a max daily volume of 20m³/day effluent to the UN-NAMED DITCH TO MENAI STRAIT at NGR SH4783065430.

UWWTD directive aims to deliver a standard level of sewage treatment throughout EC member states. This has been interpreted as prescribing a minimum of secondary biological treatment (package plant or equivalent) on all discharges made to a controlled surface water; or a minimum of primary (septic tank or equivalent) treatment on all discharges made to ground.

The discharge of 20m³/day effluent to 'UN-NAMED DITCH TO MENAI STRAIT', for the purposes of this review, is described as 'irrelevant (aquarium water discharge that does not qualift under UWWTD)'. This treatment / receiving water combination has been assessed* as NON UWWTD under the UWWTD review. This consent is reviewed as NON UWWTD under UWWTD as of 01/09/2005.

* NB: the assessment of this Discharge Consent to meet UWWTD 'appropriate treatment' criteria is based solely on provision of the appropriate 'threshold' level of minimum treatment for the receiving medium. This review does not assess appropriateness in terms of the specific river needs of the receiving water stretch.

1. On the 4 September 1987 Mona Seafoods Ltd... applied to the Welsh Water Authority for consent to make a discharge of trade effluent from The Oyster Hatchery into controlled waters.

2. Consent was deemed granted on 7 September 1987 such that the discharge could lawfully be made provided it remained consistent with the nature, composition and volume described in the application until either,

- a) the Welsh Water Authority or successors gives consent unconditionally
- or b) 3 months after consent is refused or granted subject to conditions

CONDITIONS OF CONSENT

1. The discharge shall consist only of overflows from aquaria at the Anglesey Sea Zoo
2. The discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as follows:

Discharging via: A 225mm plastic pipe.
Discharging to : An un-named ditch leading to the Menai Strait
At OS Grid Ref : SH47806543
As shown marked: Discharge point on attached map No CG0145401
3. Adequate facilities shall be provided to enable representative samples of the discharge to be safely and conveniently obtained at any time from the end of the pipe.
4. The maximum rate of flow of effluent discharged shall not exceed 15 litres per second.
5. the maximum volume of effluent discharged shall not exceed 20 cubic metres per day.
6. The receiving ditch shall be kept clear of accumulations of gravel and debris carried in the discharge.
7. The Authority shall be informed in writing as soon as reasonably practicable of any information that there has been or is likely to be discharged any of the substances listed in the attached annex.
8. The suspended solids concentration (dried at 105 degrees celsius) shall not exceed 60 milligrammes per litre.
9. The 5 day Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD ATU) determined at 20 degrees Celsius after-suppression of nitrification using allyl thiourea, shall not exceed 50 milligrammes per litre.
