



**The Eels (England and Wales) Regulations 2009
Regulation 17(5)(a) and 23(2)**

EEL SCREEN COMPLIANCE NOTICE

Under Regulation 17(4) of the Eels (England and Wales) Regulations 2009, on or after 1 January 2015, a responsible person must ensure that an eel screen is placed in a diversion structure that:

- (a) is capable of abstracting at least 20 cubic metres of water through any one point in any 24-hour period; or
- (b) returns water to a channel, bed or sea.

You, as the responsible person were on the 1st of January 2019, provided with an exemption under Reg 17(5) from the requirement to place an eel screen.

This notice confirms that the site known as Afon Ganol - Abstraction license 23/66/11/0013 (NGR - SH80297689), is now compliant with the Eels (England and Wales) Regulations 2009, the exemption previously provided to you on the 1st of January 2019 is now revoked.
