WARNING LETTER

RE: Crude Sewage discharging to ground.

Natural resources Wales believes that you have committed the following Offence:

Offences: Regulation 38 (1) Environmental Permitting Regulations 2016

It is an offence for a person to cause or knowingly permit an unauthorised discharge to ground, namely crude sewage.

(2) It is an offence for a person to fail to comply with or to contravene an environmental permit condition.

Date: 25th April 2019

This issue was first noticed during an inspection on the 25th April 2019. A verbal agreement was given that the septic tank which is discharging crude sewage would be treated as a priority and the issue rectified as soon as possible. Unfortunately, seven months have passed and the agreed work has not been started.
