Conwy County Borough Council (Penrhyn Beach Penrhyn Bay) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2020

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Conwy County Borough Council has made an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of Penrhyn Beach, Penrhyn Bay, from the junction with Glan y Mor Road to the junction of Penrhyn Beach West.

The Order is necessary to facilitate flooding prevention works. The alternative route will be to continue along the A548 to its junction with School Bank Road then turn right and continue to the junction with the A470 then turn right again and proceed to the diversions end approaching the junction with Watling Street. Access will be maintained on the unaffected section of Watling Street.

The Order comes into effect on 17 August 2020. It is anticipated that the road will be closed for a maximum period of 18 months, or until the works which it is proposed to carry out has been completed.
