Morning all,

I can confirm the report provided by EDF (version 7) addresses previous concerns raised by NRW around Cardiff Grounds' dispersive nature as a disposal site.

The quantitative re-analysis on the offset value found between the baseline and post disposal survey data was shown through further investigation to be a survey artefact and not substantial accretion. The analysis undertaken appears through evaluation to be robust and sufficient to alleviate our concerns.

We are reassured the disposal site is behaving in a dispersive nature.
