

QUEENSFERRY HOUSEHOLD WASTE RECYCLING CENTRE

Background:

This site was given Planning Consent by Alyn & Deeside District Council in October 1992 (Ref: P/4/7/21981. There were no conditions attached to this Consent which related to the removal of the site infrastructure.

The Site was granted a Waste Disposal Site Licence (179/93) which was later modified into EAWML/37072) and Environmental Permit BP3295VS. Condition 4.7.1 related to a requirement to clean, plant and equipment used, and emptying of any sealed sumps or interceptors

There were no Discharge Consents associated with this site

Site Operations:

The site was operated as a Household Waste Recycling Centre for a wide range of household generated hazardous and non-hazardous wastes from 1993 until 2015. It closed briefly when the Sandy croft Household Waste Recycling Centre opened early 2017. It re-opened whilst the Buckley Household Waste Recycling Centre was remodelled in early 2018.

The amount of wastes accepted per annum did not exceed 24,999 tonnes

In 2015/16 No wastes were processed

In 2016/17 (Q4) 666 tonnes were processed

In 2017/18 (Q1) 149 tonnes were

processed

The site consisted of a rectangular site hard surfaced with concrete. Water was drained via road gulleys and an interceptor into the foul sewer. Wastes were contained in 40 cubic hard Ro-Ro containers with regular removal to a suitably permitted disposal facility.

The site is fenced with 1.8metre high palisade fencing with lockable gates.

Current Site condition: plea

All the containers, walkways and waste have been removed. The site has been swept using a mechanical vacuum sweeper, the gulleys and interceptor were sucked out and the residues disposed of at an authorised disposal site.
