

CONNAHS QUAY HOUSEHOLD WASTE RECYCLING CENTRE

Background:

This site was given Planning Consent by Alyn & Deeside District Council in January 1983. There were no conditions attached to this Consent which related to the removal of the site infrastructure.

The Site was granted a Waste Disposal Site Licence (176/93) which was later modified into EAWML/37069 and Environmental Permit EPR/BP3299VH. Condition 4.7.1 related to a requirement to clean, plant and equipment used, and emptying of any sealed sumps or interceptors

There were no Discharge Consents associated with this site

This site closed for the reception of waste on Sunday 7th October

Wastes Accepted:

EWC Chapter 13-Oil Wastes and wastes of liquid fuels

EWC Chapter 15- Waste Packaging, Absorbents, Wiping Cloths, Filter Materials and Protective Clothing (NOS)

EWC Chapter 16- Wastes not otherwise specified including end of life tyres and oil. Gases in pressure containers and discarded chemicals

EWC Chapter 17-Construction and demolition wastes including concrete, bricks tiles and ceramics, wood, glass and plastics, metal cables, soil from excavated sites, insulation materials including asbestos insulation material, gypsum-based construction materials

EWC Chapter 20- Municipal Wastes including separately collected fractions, garden and park waste

2015/16 1595 tonnes

2016/17 2189 tonnes

2017/18 1877 tonnes

Current Site Condition:

All structures and waste on the site have been removed, the yard swept. The drainage gully's and interceptor have been cleaned out.
