Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and consolidation of an environmental permit.

This is a permit variation following the publication of the revised Best Available Techniques (BAT) Reference Document (BRef) Waste Treatment. The associated BAT conclusions to this document were published on the 17th August 2018 in the Official Journal of the European Union.

This variation incorporates the changes required by the Industrial Emissions Directive following a statutory review of permits in the Waste Treatment sector. These include the amendment of the wording of several permit conditions relating to notifications, changes to emission limits and monitoring requirements. The interpretation section of the permit has also been updated and the opportunity has been taken to consolidate the original permit and subsequent variations.

We are satisfied that the operator will be compliant with the published BAT conclusions which will apply from 17th August 2022.

The rest of the installation is unchanged and continues to be operated as follows:

The main features of the facility are as follows. Wastes generated by Envirowales' battery breaking facility at the neighbouring Rassau Industrial Estate require further treatment prior to disposal or recycling. The site at Tafarnaubach will handle:

Furnace slag, which will be crushed to reduce the particle size to meet the specifications of the final disposal site, is temporarily stored.

Drosses, which contain a significant amount of lead and other metals and impurities and will be sorted for further recycling.

Plastics, which will be stored when quantities exceed the space available at the Rassau site prior to further recycling.

Waste domestic/portable batteries, which require sorting to remove any batteries which can't be recycled at the Rassau site. Batteries are returned to the Rassau site for processing or disposal.

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit. Schedule 1 of the notice specifies the conditions that have been varied and Schedule 2 comprises a consolidated permit which reflects the changes being made.

The status log of a permit sets out the permitting history, including any changes to the permit reference number.
