Further to our review of the Treatment Hub's Duty of Care paperwork, NRW wishes to gain a further understanding of the classification of the waste exported from site. To enable us to do this we wish to review the laboratory analysis, chemical and physical validation results for all waste removed from The Treatment Hub between the same dates (1st March 2018 to 1st March 2020).

I have enclosed an EPR Reg 61 Notice to support this request and the information is required to be submitted to NRW by 8th July 2020. It can be submitted in paper form or electronically, whichever is more convenient for yourself, but please ensure the information is clearly correlated to exported consignments of waste so it can be cross referenced with the Duty of Care Paperwork.
