We need more information about your application

Application reference: PAN-011841 (EPR/YP3324GL)

Operator: Mr David Jones and Mr Philip Jones

Thank you for your application received on 15/10/2020.

We need to ask you for some more information before we can do any more work on it.
Please would you:

- As both Mr David Jones and Mr Philip Jones are named on the permit, we require signed declarations from both members. On the F2 application form the declaration from Mr David Jones has been duplicated and the declaration from Mr Philip Jones is missing, please can this be rectified?
- Provide us with more information on the swimming pool backwash effluent:
 - o You suggest the retention tank will be dosed with a chlorine neutralising substance, please can the details of the dosing material be provided to allow us to ensure it will not harm the environment (product description, material safety data sheet, any information from the manufacturer)
 - o Is the effluent going from the retention tank to the package treatment plant? If so, please can you address the following points from our guidance on swimming pool effluent:
 - Confirm it can be passed through the treatment plant without adversely impacting the treatment facility and discharge quality
 - Confirm the backwash forms a small proportion of the discharge, thus reducing the risk (provide the ratio of backwash effluent : domestic sewage effluent)
 - Get confirmation from the treatment plant manufacturer/maintenance contractor confirming the plant can effectively treat any proposed backwash
 - As per section 7f in the C6 application form, please can you confirm what the temperature of the discharge is (will it be ambient?)
