Dear Dr Richards,

Re: Environmental Permit (EPR) HP3737UE – Plant Status Update

In accordance with the requirements of Schedule 4.3 (4.3.4) – Notification, please accept this as an overview of the current operational status at the Severn Power Station.

This overview follows on from the email sent by KPMG (administrator) on the 09th September 2020 notifying NRW that Calon Energy (site owner) had entered administration.

As per the telephone discussion held on the 08th September 2020, Siemens will hold the environmental permit for the facility, and as such will continue to notify NRW in line with the reporting requirements set out within Schedule 4.2. Simon Matthews will remain as point of contact between the Severn Power Station and NRW, any change will be formally notified to NRW in advance.

It is the intention to suspend all external monitoring of the emissions system (CEMS) while the plant is non-operations, for reference 3rd party review was completed in July 2020 prior to the decision to halt operations and is therefore not required until 2021. Should the plant return to normal operations then this monitoring programmed will be reintroduced.

Overview

The asset owner Severn Power Limited have requested that Siemens O&M provide a short-term preservation strategy for the Severn Power Station assets. The proposed measures have been identified to ensure the asset's integrity, minimizing corrosion and equipment damage, during a short-term preservation period of three months with the view of transitioning into a prolonged preservation period. It is expected that at the end of the preservation implementation period, the plant will be in suitable condition for long term preservation.
