LICENCE FOR The deposit and removal of light-weight steel frames onto the seabed to test species colonisation of different substrates at Chapel Bay, Milford Haven and Skomer MCZ, Pembrokeshire.

I am pleased to advise you that the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, has considered **Swansea Universities** email dated **30 January 2020** requesting a variation to a Marine Licence under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, and hereby grant the Marine Licence for you to undertake the above stated works.

Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence **DEML1829v1** and its conditions. Please note that Marine Licence **DEML1829v1** supersedes Marine Licence **DEML1829** in its entirety.

Variation proposed to include Four floating rafts to be attached to four of the mooring buoys (one raft per mooring), in Chapel Bay for 8 months (project duration: end Feb 2020 – end Oct 2020).

Advisory Note

Marine Licence, **DEML1829v1**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

Marine Licence, **DEML1829v1** is solely granted for the work to be undertaken with the area specified in the Licence; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within 28 days of the receipt of this letter.
