Notice of part refusal of your application for a variation to your environmental permit

Permit reference: EPR/PP3993VS/V007

Applicant: Atlantic Recycling Limited

Facility: Atlantic Ecopark, Newton Road, Rumney, Cardiff, CF3 2EJ

Our determination of your application to vary your permit is complete. I enclose a notice and consolidated permit showing the changes to your permit. However we have decided to refuse one part of the variation application. The part refused is the application to operate a small waste co-incineration plant. You will find the reason for this is explained in the attached decision document. Please read this carefully.

As described below, you have the right to appeal this decision.

I would also outline other theoretical courses of action that are available, though should you wish to pursue one, it would be treated on its own merits and I make no comment on the likelihood of success. You could re-apply for a different small waste co-incineration plant of suitable and demonstrable specifications, you could re-apply for the same plant but propose the use of only clean uncontaminated waste wood and biofuel, you could apply to use the provision of Article 51 of the Industrial Emissions Directive to request authorization to change operating conditions, or you could find a different source of heat for the waste water treatment plant.

Rights of appeal

If you're not happy with our decision you may appeal to the Welsh Ministers. You must make your appeal no later than six months from the date of the variation notice.

- a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying the Welsh Ministers in writing and sending a copy of that notification to us.
