Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and consolidation of an environmental permit.

This is a permit variation following the publication of the revised Best Available Techniques (BAT) Reference Document (BRef) Waste Treatment. The associated BAT conclusions to this document were published on the 17th August 2018 in the Official Journal of the European Union.

This variation incorporates the changes required by the Industrial Emissions Directive following a statutory review of permits in the Waste Treatment sector. These include the amendment of the wording of several permit conditions relating to notifications. There are no changes to emissions limits or monitoring requirements as there are no point source emissions from the installation. The interpretation section of the permit has also been updated and the opportunity has been taken to consolidate the original permit and subsequent variations. One European Waste Catalogue (EWC) has been amended as was incorrect in the current permit, this has been amended from 06 01 11* to 16 01 11*. One EWC has been added to the permit, this is 15 02 02*, the Operator has been allowed to store this via agreement during the regulatory compliance of the site therefore the permit is updated to reflect this.

We are satisfied that the operator will be compliant with the published BAT conclusions which will apply from 17th August 2022.

The rest of the installation is unchanged and continues to be operated as follows:

The site operates as a hazardous waste transfer station for the acceptance of asbestos or asbestos-contaminated wastes only mainly from the Operator's own asbestos removal business or via the Council's own refuse collection vehicles. The waste will be transferred into secure ISO containers for storage and then sent off site for disposal. No more than 50 tonnes of asbestos or asbestos-contaminated waste will be stored on site at any one time and all asbestos received at the site arrives either double bagged or double packaged unless it is complete, unbroken, cement-bonded asbestos.

There are no emissions to air, land or surface water from the site. There is an emission point from the site for any uncontaminated surface water which leads directly into the foul water drain and eventually to sewer.

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit. Schedule 1 of the notice specifies the conditions that have been varied and Schedule 2 comprises a consolidated permit which reflects the changes being made.

The status log of a permit sets out the permitting history, including any changes to the permit reference number.
