3. What will happen next?

Any non-compliance we have identified and recorded on this form is an offence. It can result in criminal prosecution and/or suspension or revocation of your permit.

You are non-compliant with your permit.

We are currently considering taking enforcement action against you for the non-compliance recorded above. We will contact you in due course.

4. Details of our assessment

This was an unannounced site inspection carried out by Waste Regulation Officer Amy Henderson and Senior Waste Regulation Officer Steven White. The weather at the time of the visit was dry but cold and icy.

Steven Amos arrived on site a few minutes after we arrived and briefly spoke with Officers however the inspection was carried out unaccompanied.

The site was operational at the time of our visit with wagons arriving at the weighbridge before queuing to tip. Officers could see there was a substantial amount of soils in the area at the edge of the quarry void. This soil was not being stored within the permitted area outlined in Schedule 1 of the permit. It was identified the wagons on site during the time of the visit were bringing on waste consisting of just soils. This soil was being tipped near the edge of the concreted area. A digger could be seen working where the wagons were tipping, moving this tipped soil away from the concreted area. Freshly deposited soil could be seen outside the permitted area. An action has been given to ensure that waste not suitable for treatment to create aggregate must be temporarily stored within the permitted area before onward transportation following the Waste Duty of Care. You must ensure this storage is compliant with the conditions of your permit. An action has also been given to remove the waste soils from the non permitted area.

The following compliance scores have been issued as a result of this site inspection.

Table 1.1 Specified waste management operations; Limits; Storage on area of hardstanding or impermeable pavement provided in accordance with condition 2.1.

Waste soils being brought onto site were being tipped within the quarry void. This is not within the permitted area and does not meet the above condition. Schedule 1 of the permit relating to the specified land states;

This licence relates to the land at Parrys Quarry, Pinfold Lan, Alltami, Mold, Flintshire CH7 6LE (hereinafter called "the Site") shown edged in red on drawing reference R3- Jan 2006 and attached to this licence.

A CCS C3 score has been issued for this breach. Further enforcement action is being considered. There has been a delay in the issuing of this CAR form due the the considered enforcement action.
