We have received your application to vary your abstraction licence, however we are unable to accept it as valid. Please read the letter below which outlines what further information is required.

Registered address

According to your application, the registered address for R E Evans Farms Ltd is 'Orlandon Cottage, St Brides, Haverfordwest, SA62 3AP'. However, according to Companies House, the registered address for the company is 'Peterbridge House, Macintyre Hudson, The Lakes, Northampton, United Kingdom, NN4 7HB'. Please could you confirm that this is the correct registered address for the company?

Authority to act as contact

We require a letter of authorisation from a relevant person from R E Evans Ltd to provide us with confirmation that you are able to act on their behalf as the contact for this application. Please could you provide us with signed authorisation from Mark Harrod or Rachel Harrod?

Abstraction quantities

I understand from your application that you do not wish to alter the quantities of water that you are permitted to abstract.

The most recent version of the licence (attached to this email) specifies the quantities as:

57.27 cubic metres per hour
859.194 cubic metres per day
20,557.012 cubic metres per season (summer)

However, you have stated in the application form that the quantities applied for are:

400 cubic metres per hour
5000 cubic metres per day
20,557 cubic metres per season (summer).

Would you be able to clarify this, or alternatively, confirm that you do request an increase to your maximum daily and hourly quantities?

Map of boundaries

Thank you for providing a map with your application. From my understanding, the boundary lines of the areas owned by the applicant are all shaded in a crimson colour (corresponding to 'LOT 1'). Can you confirm that my understanding is correct?

Second abstraction point location

Please can you confirm the 12-figure National Grid Reference of the proposed second abstraction point? From my observations, it is located at a small pond at Grid Reference SR 92779 99075. Can you confirm whether you agree with this suggestion?
