This brief statement is in reference to enquiry Q2 1030 in relation to the return of wind blown sand from a paved public seating area back onto Castle Beach in Tenby.

The project will be managed by Pembrokeshire County Council

The working hours for this project are 7:30am to 13:30pm Monday to Friday (if required). No work will be undertaken at the weekends or Bank Holidays

Prior to work commencing, the work site boundary will be established with signage and barriers erected ensuring that the general public will be separated from the works and all work areas are secure.

The project will be supervised by a member of Pembrokeshire County Councils supervisory staff and will be responsible for making themselves aware of the issues on site and ensuring the operatives and subcontractors (if required) take the appropriate action.

The returning of the sand will be carried out mainly by a mini-excavator which will enter the work site via a pathway leading to the paved seating area (no machine will enter the beach area) and will remove and replace sand as it works its way down the work site. Areas which are unaccessible to the mini-excavator will be addressed manually with the sand being loaded into wheelbarrows and returned to the beach via a slipway located next to the seating area
