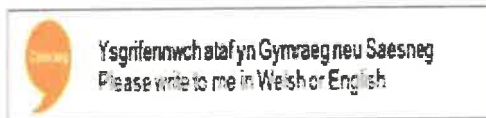

Subject: Maintenance Of Highway Outlets at Beaumaris and Llanfaes

The LHA for Anglesey has requested Cadarn to undertake application of licenses to carry out regular maintenance of the outlets of highway drainage pipes located along the coast at Beaumaris and Llanfaes.

I have listed the approximate locations and general details of the structures in the attached .xlsx files. The client requires to undertake periodic clearance of material surrounding the outlets using a small machine and minimum personnel. As the work is to be carried out during low tides it is not envisaged that this work will not effect the safety of navigation.

Applied ecological Services Ltd have prepared an Extended Phase 1 Habitat Survey for the outlets at Beaumaris and at Llanfaes. It is concluded that the impact on the environment and associated ecology will be minimal and that a Band 1 application is undertaken to carry out eligible activity –“ clearance/removal of beach material in and around outfalls to aid drainage”.

A Marine Management Organisation – Licence Requirement Check concludes that a MMO licence is not required.

A draft method statement of the works is also attached.
