## **MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009: PART 4 – MARINE LICENSING**

### **LICENCE FOR MARINE ENERGY TEST AREA (META) PHASE 2 SITES: WARRIOR WAY, DALE ROADS AND EAST PICKARD BAY; WITHIN AND IN PROXIMITY TO THE MILFORD HAVEN WATERWAY, PEMBROKESHIRE**

I am pleased to advise you that the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, has considered the submitted online form by yourself to Permit receipt on 30 July 2021 and received into the Marine Licensing Team on 3 August 2021 requesting a complex variation relating to a Marine Licence under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, and hereby grant the Marine Licence for you to undertake the above stated works.

Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence **ORML1957v1** and its conditions. Please note that Marine Licence **ORML1957v1** supersedes Marine Licence ORML1957 in its entirety.

The licence has been varied to remove Conditions 3.28 and 3.31 relating to Little Grebe *Tachybaptus ruficolis* as a result of a change in advice from NRW Advisory. We have also corrected the typographical error within Appendix 1.3.

#### **Advisory Note**

Marine Licence, **ORML1957v1**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

Marine Licence, **ORML1957v1** is solely granted for the work to be undertaken with the area specified in the Licence; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a routine variation for a possible extension of the Licence period **at least 2 months** prior to the expiry date.

For a replacement marine licence or a formal complex variation, the Licence Holder should apply **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within **28 days** of the receipt of this letter.

Finally, once again, please ensure you have read and understood Marine Licence ORML1957v1. Should you have any queries with regards to your Marine Licence then please do not hesitate to contact the Marine Licensing Team.

Following the UK's departure from the EU on 31 January 2020 and the end of the transition period on 31 December 2020, the legal obligations relating to compliance with environmental permits and legislation will continue to apply. NRW will continue to issue and regulate all permits and licenses in line with our current practice.
