**ENFORCEMENT NOTICE TO TAKE SPECIFIED STEPS IN RELATION TO A
BREACH/ANTICIPATED BREACH OF PERMIT CONDITION(S)**

Natural Resources Wales considers that the following conditions of the environmental permit are being contravened: 2.1.1 - Storage of wastes; 2.2.1 – Clear distinction between permitted and exempt activity; 3.1.1 – Site infrastructure and 5.1.4 – Leaks and spillages, because 2.1.1 storage of baled ELV's on earthen bank of operation and not on appropriate surface, 2.2.1 storage of non-conforming ELV's and wastes under the area identified as a T9 waste exemption operation, 3.1.1 storage of wastes on an area that is not constructed or maintained to the conditions of Table 3.1 and 5.1.4 Failure to remediate and clear oil spills on site as required under Table 5.1.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the date(s) specified in order to remedy the contraventions.

General

2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.
3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(1)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

At the same time you must send a copy of the appeal notice and documents to Natural Resources Wales.

The required documents are:

- A statement of the grounds of appeal
- A copy of any relevant application
- A copy of any relevant environmental permit
- A copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator
- A copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal
- A statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying The Planning Inspectorate in writing and sending a copy of that notification to Natural Resources Wales. Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from The Planning Inspectorate detailed above.

Legislation note

In this document "Natural Resources Wales" means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.

2.2.1	Remove all non-conforming wastes from the identified T9 area and ensure that the exempt and waste permitted operations are kept separate.	18/11/2021
3.1.1 & 3.1.2	Ensure that maintenance of the sites impermeable area is completed to the standards listed in Table 3.1. a) Provide evidence to NRW that the maintenance of the sites infrastructure is to an appropriate standard as required under condition 3.1.2 and Table 3.1.	18/11/2021
5.1.4	Ensure that all oil spills are identified and cleared appropriately in line with the standards of Table 5.1 of the permit.	18/11/2021
