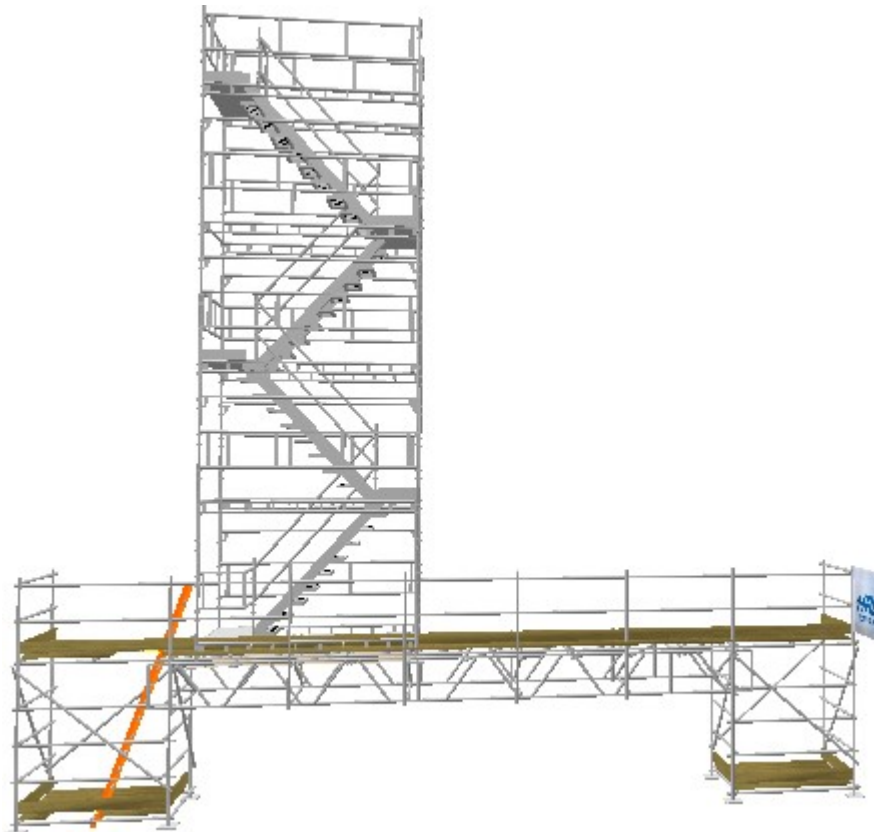


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Item No: 1 of 3	Item Name: Item 1. Elevation	Quantity: 1

CANTILEVER from inside service road supported by tower and also suspending from steel beams in roof. With bridge and stairs off above.



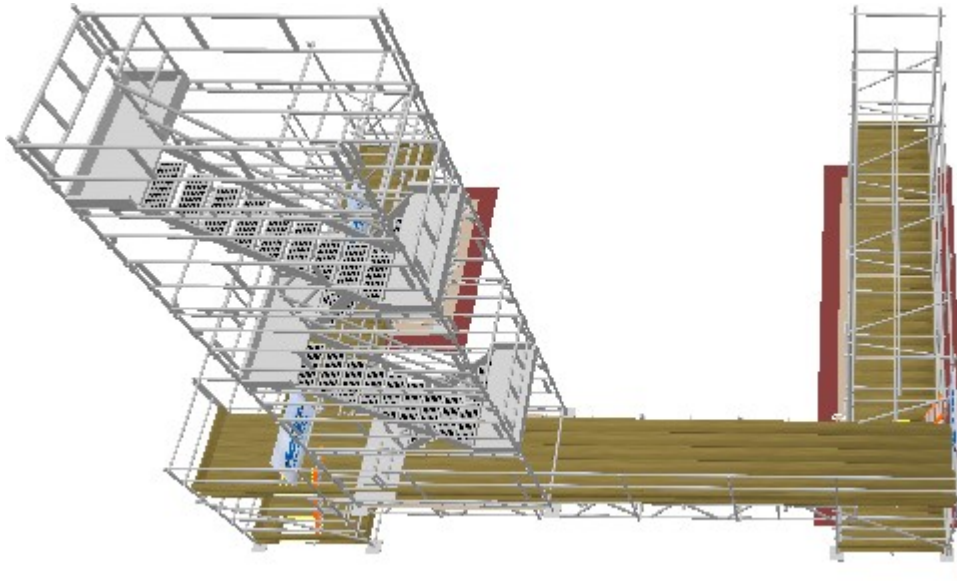

CANTILEVER from inside service road supported by towers and also suspending from steel beams in roof. With bridge and stairs off above.

Terms and Conditions:

1. This quotation is open for acceptance within three months from the date thereof, subject to the Company having labour and materials available and receiving 14 days notice to commence work within two months after receipt of the Customer's order.
2. Any order placed is subject to acceptance by the Company in writing. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, any order resulting from this quotation shall be deemed to include acceptance of the conditions contained within it by the Customer, which shall apply to the exclusion of any conditions contained or referred to in the Customer's order or enquiry.
3. The hire period is to commence on and include the first day of delivery of materials and will continue until written Confirmation of your instruction to finally dismantle is received. Where site conditions, or any other factor beyond the control of the Company prevent the Company from removing its material from the site, then it shall remain on hire to the Customer until it can be removed.
4. If progress on or completion of the work specified within this quotation is delayed for any reason beyond the control of the Company, such as weather conditions, delays in obtaining materials in short supply, unsuitable access to site, strikes, or any other cause or circumstances beyond the control of the Company, a fair and reasonable extension of time for executing or completing the work shall be granted to the Company and the Company shall be under no liability for any consequential damage which the Customer may suffer by reason of any such delays aforesaid.
5. Any additions, alterations, adaptations or variations required to the structure will be carried out on receipt of written instructions from the Customer. The Customer shall obtain an estimate of such extra costs from the Company and confirm acceptance thereof before requiring any alterations or extra work to be put in hand.
6. The Company reserve the right to adjust the contract price to account for any increase in the rate of wages and other emoluments and expenses payable to their operatives engaged upon the erection of scaffolding in accordance with the rules, or decisions of the National Joint Council for the Building Industry.
7. It is the Customer's responsibility for obtaining and maintaining all consents, licences or permits required to comply with any statute, bye-law or regulations in force of any government, municipality or other competent authority.
8. It is the Customer's responsibility to supply, fix and maintain any warning lamps, notices or pavement licences that may be required throughout the contract.
9. The Customer should ensure that adequate facilities for tying are made available and be responsible for providing a foundation of adequate bearing strength to support the loads to be applied.
10. The Company will exercise all responsible care to ensure that the structure is soundly and adequately constructed for the purpose requested by the customer and that when erected it will comply with all current statutory regulations applicable.
11. The Customer shall not sublet or lend the Company's materials to any third party and shall not remove or cause or permit the removal of the material from the site to which it was delivered, without the Company's prior consent, to be confirmed in writing.
12. All materials let out on hire remains the property of the Company. In the event of default in payment by the Customer, the latter shall, so far as they lawfully can, assist the Company to resume possession of the goods.
13. (a) No contra claims shall be set off against our invoices without our written approval.
(b) We shall not meet any claims for loss or damages to the persons or property of the customer's or any third party unless such loss or damage is notified to us in writing within seven days of occurring.
(c) No retentions shall be made by you of any kind whatsoever and no part of the contract price shall be retained under any circumstances without our prior agreement in writing.
14. Whilst all reasonable care will be taken *when* erecting and dismantling scaffolding to prevent any damage, this quotation is submitted on the express condition that the Company is not held responsible for any accidental damage to property or associated land upon which the scaffold is erected.
15. Payment to be against invoices rendered within 28 days. In the event of overdue accounts the Company shall without prejudice to any right to damages withhold further deliveries until payment is made and/or cancel the contract in respect of the whole, or part of the remaining work by giving seven days notice in writing to the Customer to suspend the work for so long as payment is outstanding.
16. All materials on hire are the responsibility of the hirer from delivery to site to return to our depot on completion of hire. Any damage or lost materials will be charged in full at the replacement value current at the time of return.
17. The Customer is the person, firm or Company to whom this quotation is addressed.
