Invalid Application

Dear Mr. Moore

We have received your application for a licence, but it is not complete.

Applicant details

You have specified that 'Welsh Water Capital Delivery Alliance' is the applicant for this application. My understanding is that this alliance is overseen by Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig, who are the legal owners of the land of which the proposed abstractions are sited.

If my understanding of the above is correct, then the company applying for this licence (and therefore the named licence holder) should be Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig, and the agent is Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure. Can you confirm that this is correct?

Registered address

You have stated that the applicant's registered address is 'Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure, Dŵr Cymru, Ty Awen, Spooner Close, Coedkernew, Newport, NP10 8FZ.

According to Companies House, this is not the legal registered address for Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure, nor that of Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig.

If you wish to apply on the basis of Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig being the applicant, and Morgan Construction & Infrastructure being the agent, you will need to confirm the legal registered addresses for both entities.

Signatory details

The declaration and signature for this application has been completed by yourself (Sam Moore). However, in order to validate this application we require the signature and authorisation from both legal entities (Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig & Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure) that you are able to act on their behalf.

We will accept authorisation from any active 'relevant' persons according to Companies House, or in the case of Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig, we will accept applications signed by the following individuals: Ian Christie, Clare Walters (Head of WW Science & Business Improvement), Claire Scannell (Wastewater Regulation Manager), James Camis (Environmental Permitting Specialist) and Mathew Griffiths (Environmental Consenting Specialist).

Please can you therefore provide signatures of 'relevant people' from both Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig and Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure, and authorisation from both entities that you are able to act on their behalf.

Abstraction quantities

You have applied for the following quantities/periods:

Abstraction period	2 months
Maximum annual abstraction volume	44064 m ³
Maximum daily abstraction volume	740 m ³
Maximum hourly abstraction volume	30.6 m ³
Number of hours of abstraction per day	24 hours
Peak abstraction rate	8.5 l/s

Based on your previous correspondence with us, I understand that you have rounded the daily figure up to the nearest 10 m³ per day. We recommend that you do not do this in order to be consistent with the rest of the volumes applied for.

If you were to apply for the calculated figure of **734.4 m³/day**, this ensures that all of the other volumes multiply up consistently. Can you confirm that you would like to apply for this recommended revised daily volume?


Abstraction location

According to your submitted WRA form, you have stated that the abstraction point is at NGR SN62113209881. This NGR is located near Ffairfach, Carmarthenshire. This appears to be an error, and I also recognize that you are applying for more than one abstraction point. According to the site layout document that you submitted, my understanding is that you wish to apply for six abstraction points. Please can you confirm how many abstraction points you wish to apply for, and provide the correct NGRs for these points?

Discharge location

According to your submitted WRD form, you have stated that the discharge point is at NGR SN6211409881. According to the site plan you provided, the discharge point is at the existing inlet works adjacent to Primary Settlement Tank No. 1.

I therefore consider the discharge point to be at SN 62193 09915 (See below).



Can you confirm that my understanding is correct?

Discharge details

I understand that discharged water will be introduced into the Garnswllt WWTW at the above inlet point. An environmental discharge permit exists for this site, under licence ref. BC0006801. This permit authorises treated water to be discharged into the River Loughor. Can you confirm that your proposed abstraction will discharge water under the same arrangements into the River Loughor?

If we have not received the information we have asked for within 28 days of the date of this letter, we cannot accept your application and we will return it to you, along with your application fee.
