	Board to construct and maintain an under-ground aqueduct shown by a BLUE line within a strip of land 70 yds. wide for the purpose of diverting water into the Afon Hengwyn.		
A-B	Board to construct and maintain a roadway coloured BROWN between points A and B. Maintenance after construction to be shared according to user.		Board has a right of way over existing roads and tracks coloured <u>BROWN</u> .
	Board to improve, widen and maintain the bed and banks of the Afon Hengwyn for a distance of 330 yds. below the aqueduct outfall in the area hatched RED.		
	Board to erect a boathouse to be used by the vendor on a site to be agreed.		
C-D	Board to construct and maintain a bridge suitable for foot passengers and sheep between points C and D.		
	Where roads and tracks join a public highway Board to erect signs indicating that the road or track is private.		
	After raising the level of the lake Board to remove all floating obstructions.		
	<u>Reserved to the vendors all sporting and fishing rights.</u>		
	Board not to make any substantial alteration to the level of the lake and to endeavour to secure that there is no substantial fluctuation in the water level.		
	Board to ensure that fishing is not affected during construction work.		
	Board will not acquire any fishing rights, the Vendors to stock the lake and have right to maintain two rowing boats and a boathouse, but this will not prevent the Board from going on to the lake for construction or maintenance purposes.		No sheep to be dipped in the lake or any water flowing into the lake.
	If within a period of 10 years from the completion of construction work it is shown that injury to fishing in the lake has been caused, the Board to remedy the position or pay compensation.
