This was a routine unannounced site inspection by Natural Resources Wales (NRW) officer Alastair Wilson (Environment Officer).

Throughout the inspection weather conditions were cool, overcast, with no precipitation. The site was operating with one member of staff at the weighbridge, and council bin lorries arriving, dropping off waste, and then departing.

Upon arrival the officer introduced himself to the weighbridge supervisor who showed the officer around the site. After the visit had finished, but while the officer was still in the area the site technically competent manager arrived on site and invited the officer to return to the site to discuss infrastructure improvements.

A walk around of the permitted area was carried out, in general the site appeared clean and tidy. The officer was able to observe waste lorries entering the site and depositing waste in the appropriate bays.



A small pile of around 30 tyres were being stored on the grass next to the main building. Mr Williams explained that they were in this location while the new bays were being constructed on site. These tyres must be moved into a bay on an impermeable surface.

**CAR sub-criteria B4, permit condition 1.1.1, Compliance Classification Scheme Category 4 breach.** *This waste should be stored within a bay, however, Mr Williams explained that they were only temporarily in this location while the new bays were being constructed. As there is an improvement plan in place **this score has been suspended.***



The main building on the site, and the green waste bay is served by drainage that goes to the foul sewer. However, bays containing glass and waste wood currently drain to surface water via an interceptor, from which there is a risk of a point source emission to water.

**CAR sub-criteria B3, permit condition 3.1.1, Compliance Classification Scheme Category 3 breach.** *There is a risk of contamination of surface waters via the drainage which serves the waste glass and waste wood bays. This was noted in compliance report ID: CAR\_NRW0032619 and was given a category 3 breach. This drainage problem still exists, however as there is an improvement plan in place **this score has been suspended.***



Once you have completed the improvement works you should ensure that you are compliant with your permit, that your environment management system is up to date, and reflects the new operating procedures.

No other issues were observed on the visit.
