Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above environmental permit applications. We have consulted with our colleagues at the Environmental Public Health Service (delivered collaboratively through Public Health Wales' Health Protection Team and Public Health England's Centre for Radiation, Chemical and Environmental Hazards Wales).

Provided that Best Available Techniques (BAT) and management controls are applied as per relevant guidance, then there is limited potential for risk to public health from activities undertaken at the application sites.

We would recommend, if not already done so, that the applicant should agree with the Regulator a timetable for seeking external accreditation for the Environmental Management System (EMS) e.g. ISO4001 standard.

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Should you be aware of any specific public health issue or concerns raised by communities in relation to these applications, then we would be happy to assist in reviewing these.
