Environmental Permitting (England & Wales) Regulations 2010

Application for: Permit to operate a beverage production plant and process waste plant at Radnor Hills Mineral Water Company Limited, Heartsease, Knighton, Powys, LD7 1LU.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above environmental permit application. We have consulted with our colleagues at the Environmental Public Health Service (delivered collaboratively through Public Health Wales' Health Protection Team and Public Health England's Centre for Radiation, Chemical and Environmental Hazards Wales).

Provided that Best Available Techniques (BAT) and management controls are applied as per relevant guidance, and compliance with process emission limits is ensured, then there is limited potential for risk to public health from activities undertaken at the application site.

We would recommend, if not already done so, that the applicant should agree with the Regulator a timetable for seeking external accreditation for the Environmental Management System (EMS) e.g. ISO4001 standard.
