Further to your email dated 12 April 2017, I would like to confirm that the site in Bedwas is operating the anodizing process.

We have been operating the process since 01 June 2017 on a slow build. The site is operating on two shifts only (6am to 10pm daily when in operation). The site still does not operate every day. The site has not yet been formally announced in the media nor within SAPA so far but this is expected soon.


I can confirm that our current activities are still within the parameters in the existing permit which are Anodising and Fabrication activities.

There are no activities related to Extrusion or Die activities on site. We have cleared and cleaned a lot of areas. We have removed the oil storage area for P22 press and the oil storage for P16 press. We are currently not using the bulk storage tanks for anodizing and using IBC storage instead. IBC containers are in designated storage areas.

Welsh Water are visiting once per month to sample the waste water from effluent plant and I have had one sample analyzed externally so far by STL.
