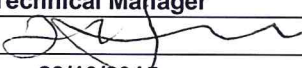

Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to prevent a recurrence of the incident	The ice machine was disconnected and not used after the day of complaint. New parts have now been fitted to the machine that prevents the ice backing up. The ice machine has been removed from the outside area and has now been installed internally into the offal processing area thereby significantly reducing any noise nuisance to neighbours living in close proximity to the plant. This work was completed yesterday Tuesday 27th October 2015. Trailer parking – All vehicles that are loaded, parked and awaiting dispatch run solely on electric. Since the 8th October 2015 there has been an improvement on site, with new electric points fitted on the loading docks, where possible, all trailers being loaded now run on electric. If the trailer has been run at ambient for several hours prior to loading it may require an extra boost by running on diesel for the duration of loading, this will be for a maximum period of 2 hours, and however under normal conditions this is unlikely to be a regular occurrence. All loaded trailers are transported

	from loading docks to their park positions with no refrigeration running, they are then immediately connected to electric points once parked.
