

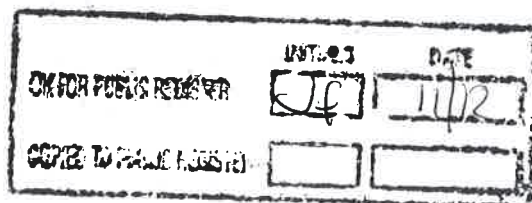

Dear Julia,

Thank you for your time today to go through progress and next steps regarding Regulation 36 and 61 Enforcement Notice responses. As discussed, items that have already been actioned are:

1. Item 10/11 - Air compressor unit has been relocated internally within the building, this is now approx. 30m further away from the boundary from its original position, generating significantly less noise emissions at both source and boundary locations, this was completed on 18th November 2017.
2. Item 26 -- Vacuum system was to be screened on two sides with acoustic panelling, following trials, it was decided to upgrade this completely box in on four sides, but leaving the top open for ventilation, initial recording of noise levels have shown a 10dB reduction. Completed 25th November 2017.
3. Item 7 -- Floor mounted compressor has been relocated to a position behind the water tank with an acoustic cladding inside the housing cover, this has significantly reduced noise emissions from this unit, making it inaudible at boundary.
4. Item 2 -- Eco cooler, although there are 5 units mounted on this side of the building, only one is considered to be a major contributor to noise emissions, however, the entire bank of these units will be cladded to a height from the base of the units to 2m above. The anticipated completion date of this is to be confirmed due to manufacture of materials.

As discussed, I am requesting an extension on the date line on R36/R61 notices to supply data, as explained, our contracted acoustic consultant has ceased operating, unfortunately this was mid-way through processing the data, David Green (Engreen Environmental Consultants) has agreed to take on finalising the data to hand over to NRW on, or before, 15th December 2017, there was also delays in passing information back and forth to RPF's solicitor for confirmation of compliance, unfortunately, this combination of delays has resulted in not all the data required being delivered.

This revised report will include items 9, 21, 27, and 28 these had been missed of due to them being deemed very low sound emitters; this will be clarified on the report, all data will be recalculated before resubmitting.

Last night's sound monitoring exercise resulted in background readings averaging at 34.53dB compared to the results recorded by Powys County Council of 34.4dB. Boundary noise levels were recorded at:
