Please provide further details on the nature of the discharge to ground from the fermenters through the soakaways that were mentioned in your supporting documents BIOCAT 1 and the Geological survey (BIOCAT 5 section 7.6). This response should include (but not limited to) details on the following:
 - a. Confirmation on what causes the discharge and that it occurs through the soakaway
 - b. Frequency (per year) of discharge to ground from the fermenters and boilers.
 - c. Volume of the discharge during an ventilation event.
 - d. the predicted contents and concentrations that are typically contained in the discharged.
 - e. What situations occurs to cause an “emergency ventilation” to occur that results in the condensation that discharges to ground.
