The marine license (CML1956v2) is due to expire on 30 January 2022. Unfortunately the current onsite works have been delayed due to rock availability in the last quarter before Christmas. As such we would like to request a minimum of a 6 month extension to the marine license in order for these works to be completed because we are still suffering from rock availability issues. Although we could probably only need say a 3month extension, we think it would be prudent under the current circumstances and potential risks that we obtain an extension for 6 months.

We had alternatively hoped (to overcome the above issue) that the new marine license (CML2108) may have 'superseded' the previously license and covered the same area, but we have noticed that the latest license states the following 'A section of the works has already been licensed under CML1956, including modifications to one of the 5 existing outfalls. CML2108 assesses the scheme as a whole but will only licence the area to the west of CML1956 and piling activity within the CML1956 area.

As such, we require the current license relevant to the area covered by the license CML1956v2 to be extended for a duration of 6 months in order for the works in the area - which are currently ongoing - to be completed.
