Reasons for refusal

1. We are refusing this application because of the short term impact of Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂). The evidence of increasing air pollution and ill health effects is strong and any deterioration of local air quality is likely to have an adverse health and wellbeing impact to a deprived community.
