

Emissions Report, 2017

Form Air1: no monitoring has been conducted during 2017. The reported values in 2016 showed emissions at their peak and over the whole of the batch process to exceed the limits of the permit for two of the processes. We will be using these values to carry out a new H1 assessment and discussing this further with NRW.

Form Perf1: refinements to the processes have led to a further reduction in solvent consumption per tonne of product for all processes of around 2% compared to 2016 whilst output has fallen by around 30%.

Water consumption has decreased slightly from 2016, by 14%, but due to a fall in output the specific usage has increased by 23%. Energy consumption is up by 5%, due increased use of the building for production in other departments.

Hazardous waste has decreased by 13% due process refinements. Non-hazardous waste appears to be down 50% but no data is available for the amount of mixed recycling produced across the site.
