RE: Environmental Permitting Regs. 2013 Application number: PAN-000869, Biomass UK No.2 Ltd. Incinerator, Barry Dock

Thank you for providing the collated public health concerns submitted to NRW during your routine permit consultation process.

As you will be aware we have submitted a public health risk assessment based on the emission information available at the time of the original consultation.

Our assessment of impacts has regard to current air quality objectives and environmental assessment levels for the protection of human health. Whilst we acknowledge the specific health queries raised by the public, we found no grounds to object based on public health impacts from process stack emissions.

Please be advised that we have also met with representatives of the Docks Incineration Action Group (DIAG) where health concerns were discussed in a local context.

We understand that NRW has sought additional information from the site operators. PHW and the health board would appreciate an opportunity to review any additional information that could change our public health risk assessment.
