Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the permit

The following notice is issued under regulation 17 of The Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (S.I.2000 No. 1973 (as amended) (the Regulations) to vary the conditions of a permit issued under the Regulations to operate part of an installation. The notice comprises schedule 1 containing conditions to be deleted, schedule 2 conditions to be amended and schedule 3 conditions to be added.

The reason for the variation is that Permit DP3732SQ does not authorise the treatment of landfill leachate. The Operator applied to the Agency to treat leachate in order to comply with permit condition 2.5 Improvement Programme requirement number 10.

It is recorded that leachate will now be pumped from the holding lagoons to an on-site leachate treatment plant, to be treated prior to discharge into the sewer. Effluent used on site for dust suppression/waste treatment is subject to approval in writing by the Agency. Use for spray irrigation is not permitted.


