24th November 2016 - Routine Site Inspection with Simon Milford – Site Manager.

- Discussed new NRW Incident hotline (03000 65 3000) – 24hr this will replace the existing 0800 807060 (naturalresources.wales/reportit)
- Extra temporary capping 3500m² installed with an extra 15 pinn wells.
- 5 deep gas extraction wells being installed at approximately 20m depth.
- Community daily FID Surveys in community has not detected any landfill gas or landfill odours to date.
- Fire Prevention Plan – NRW have given an extension to this submitting this until March 2017
- No odours detected during time of site inspection.
- Some windblown around site being collected at time of inspection (No litter on perimeter fencing or off site)

2nd December 2016 – Routine Site Inspection with Simon Milford, Steve Thayer and Kellie Burston – Biffa Waste Services - Main focus of this site meeting is to discuss over extraction of landfill gas from site.

- Landfill Tax devolution to Wales launch took place at site this week, no issues, event went well.
- Biffa Waste Services notified NRW of the possibility of three clinical waste bags getting collected from an orthodontist (gloves, wipes etc. – no blood products) accidentally being deposited in a general waste bin and disposed of at Trecatti. Although every effort has been undertaken to try and retrieve this waste by the producer, carrier and disposal site, this was not possible. NRW accept that this is now best left disposed of at the landfill site and will follow up with the producer with advice and guidance.
- Treacii had received an odour complaint direct to site on the 1st December 2017 at 10:30. There were no issues on site at this time, however the site was drilling gas wells at the time of the complaint. Since this time installation of three of the five wells have now been completed and well heads connected to gas infrastructure. FID Surveys are being undertaken on a daily basis in the community with no issues identified.
- Discussed reduction in suction pressure from 2200mb – 2000mb (reduction -200mb). This will be on trial basis as the site needs analyse gas quality and data and will only take place between Monday and Friday. Gas quality on the 28th November 2016 (SP= -133mb, O₂=1.61% and CH₄ = 40.2%). NRW will be provided with an update by GTE on the 8th December 2016 – ACTION BIFFA
- Discussed the installation of the new five deep gas wells and Biffa confirmed good yields at the moment with CH₄ at 60% (well depth 18-20m)
