Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for Ty Garreg Landfill operated by Mr David Thomas.

The permit number is EPR/CP3599FB

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Extent of the surrender application	The operator has provided a plan showing the extent of the site of the facility that is to be surrendered. We consider this plan to be satisfactory.	✓
Agreed closure & aftercare plan	We are satisfied that the agreed closure and aftercare plan has been implemented.	✓
Pollution risk	We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility.	✓
Satisfactory state	We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to return the site of the regulated facility to a satisfactory state. In coming to this decision we have had regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation. Following a review of the applicants surrender report, and a site visit accompanied by colleagues from Geoscience and a Landfill Gas Specialist, we are satisfied that the undisturbed contents of the site are unlikely to pose a pollution risk in the landfill’s environmental setting.	✓
