Schedule

The following information is required to assess the variation application for Convatec Limited:

1. In relation to the proposed regenerative thermal oxidiser, please assess the impact of sound on nearby sensitive human receptors and designated habitats sites, and demonstrate that you are using Best Available Techniques to minimise any noise impact.

The assessment for human receptors must use the methodology given in BS4142:2014 "Methods for rating and assessing industrial and commercial sound", and if modelling files are required as part of the impact assessment you must provide the information required in the following document:

For ecological receptors, you may want to consider the World Health Organisation's guideline values for community noise in the preservation of quiet outdoor areas. The assessment must include an evaluation of the character of the sound, e.g. frequency components.

2. Please provide a site plan which shows the site boundary outlined in green and clearly marking the location of all emission points.

3. In your odour impact assessment, you have assumed an odour emission limit value of 500ouE/m³, which you state has been provided by TSL. Please provide evidence of this, e.g. in the form of correspondence with TSL.

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
