Any more accurate information on the matters for notification under Part A.	CELSA were operating with low scrap stock levels. As stockpiles decrease in the scrap bay, the concentration of non-ferrous material will increase (i.e the non-metallics fall to the bottom. Scrap screening is undertaken to limit the amount of non ferrous material. However, when levels in the bay become low, the non ferrous material at the bottom of the bays can potentially get picked up and charged in the furnace. Additionally, water leaks in T1 and T2 of the ducting leading to the Quench Tower following 4 th hole abstraction may have prevented complete combustion. Repairs were undertaken on the 18/02/2016 during the 8 hour Planned Preventative Maintenance. The CO readings have returned to normal levels.
