We have decided to issue the variation for Tremorfa Melt Shop operated by CELSA Manufacturing (UK) Limited.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

Summary

This variation allows an increase in storage capacity for millscale at the 'Minerals Site' area of the installation. Millscale storage capacity has been increased from 2,000 tonnes to 6,000. The additional millscale will be stored on existing impermeable hardstanding and therefore emissions from the additional material will be controlled by the existing drainage system and the operator's site operational techniques.

Key issues of the decision

European Directives

All applicable European directives have been considered in the determination of the application.

Biodiversity, Heritage, Landscape and Nature Conservation

The application is within the relevant distance criteria of a site of heritage, landscape or nature conservation, and/or protected species or habitat .

A full assessment of the application and its potential to affect the habitats has not been carried out as part of the permitting process. This is because we consider that the application will not affect the features habitat because there are no additional pollutant linkages associated with the increase in permitted storage capacity of millscale.

Environmental Risk Assessment

Water

Based upon the information in the application we are satisfied that the appropriate measures will be in place to prevent pollution of ground and surface water.

Fugitive emissions

Based upon the information in the application we are satisfied that the appropriate measures will be in place to prevent or where that is not practicable to minimise fugitive emissions and to prevent pollution from fugitive emissions.

Operating techniques

In relation to the additional storage of millscale, we are satisfied that the operator's existing operating techniques are satisfactory.

Waste types

The permitted waste types and descriptions which can be accepted at the regulated facility have not changed as a result of this variation. The variation allows an increase in storage capacity for millscale at the 'Minerals Site' area of the installation.

Incorporating the application

We have specified that the applicant must operate the permit in accordance with descriptions in the application, including all additional information received as part of the determination process.
