Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to stop the emission	A full investigation was completed. Yard and roof areas were reviewed, no visible sources of on-site contamination were detected. A sample of rainwater was collected in a clean container at the time the above W5 sample was collected, and the rainwater ammoniacal nitrogen result was 0.6mg/l and Conductivity was 1170uS/cm. Permit is under BREF review at present and Dunbia have requested NRW consider reviewing discharge limits for W5 as part of this process.

Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to prevent a recurrence of the incident	Until NRW have an opportunity to review emission limits set for W5 a sample of the rainwater will continue to be collected in a clean container when the W5 water sample is taken to obtain additional information that may be useful if future exceedance investigations of W5 are required.

Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to rectify, limit or prevent any pollution of the environment or harm which has been or may be caused by the emission	It is not currently possible for Dunbia personnel to clean any gutters due to conditions on the roof. Dunbia will sample water at the next available opportunity and clean gutters when safe to do so.
