REPORTING OF WASTE RETURNS

Comments:

Decrease in general waste in line with the decrease of production in 2021.

Decrease in cardboard in line with decrease of production in 2021.

Slight increase in dry mixed recycling due to focus on improving waste segregation to increase recycling in 2021.

Decrease in Effluent plant sludge due to the reduction in use of the travel oven in the Cooked Department, therefore influent FOG was lower.

Butchery Waste is meat that has fallen on the floor and is classed as Animal By-Products, therefore not required to be reported as a waste under EPR Permit Reporting.

Interceptor waste added this year due to increased maintenance and cleaning.

Waste oil is collected on an ad hoc basis, following servicing of equipment. Quantity is small and not generated every year.

Less Food / Ingredient and cooking oil waste this year due to improved efficiencies.
