Thank you for your time and co-operation during our visit to the above farm on 14th January 2013 to discuss your permit and carry out an inspection.

As you are aware the Environment Agency has a duty to carry out inspections of sites regulated by such permits.

The following issues were noted during the inspection

General Management 1.1:

No Entrance sign visible to the public from outside of the site was on display The sign must be a minimum of A4 size, be waterproof and have:

- the emergency contact name and telephone number of the operator; and
- a statement that the site is permitted by the Environment Agency; and
- the permit number; and the Environment Agency national numbers, 03708 506506 and 0800 807060.

2.3.4 Spreading on land – manure and nutrient status

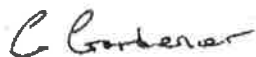
The most recent records seen for analysis of manures was 03/11/2011, the analysis should be repeated twice yearly, so a new analysis should be arranged asap and repeated every six months in future. Also there should be an analysis of the soil for the land where the manure is spread every five years.

When you have the latest manure and soils analysis please can you send me copies.

All other documentation requested at the inspection in December 2012 was seen and complete and no breaches of the conditions of the permit were seen during the inspection
